

Environmental Measures

(a) DISPOSAL OF FLOWERS – Removed by Funeral Director/ Leave in Chapel/ Display in Floral Area (please be aware that floral tributes will be removed from this area between 7-10 days from the day of the funeral)

(b) METAL RESIDUES – All metals remaining following cremation will be disposed of in the most suitable manner to reduce the impact on our environment. This will include the sensitive recycling of metals to avoid the use of non-renewable resources and comply with existing legislation. Should you wish to dispose of the metals in any other way then please indicate by ticking the box and metals will be returned to you within the cremated remains or separately from them.

(c) I am aware cremation may not take place on the same day but that it will normally be completed within 24 hours of the service.

Cremated Remains will be returned in an eco container and must be collected within 28 days of the service to avoid additional fees.
